Important information for Managers/Team Administrators:

This tournament has implemented a touchless, electronic method for submitting required documentation for this tournament in a partnership with [SportsForms](#). This means all documents that would typically be brought to an on-site Team Registration location on the Friday of the tournament will instead be submitted, reviewed and approved online, in advance of the start of the tournament. THERE WILL ABSOLUTELY BE NO REGISTRATION AT THE FIELDS.

Documents Required to Participate:

- 1. Copy of Official Roster(s) covering all Rostered Players (including Club Pass and Guest)**
- 2. Copy of Player Passcards picture side for all Roster Players (including Club Pass and Guest)**
- 3. Event Liability Waiver - Must be signed electronically for a Parent/Guardian for all Players**
- 4. Guest Player Approval Forms (if applicable)**
- 5. Copy of RM cards (US teams only) for any personnel in the team's Bench Area during the event**
- 6. Contact Information**
- 7. Out of State Travel permit, if applicable**
- 8. Copy of Concussion Certificate for any team personnel in the Bench Area during the event**
- 9. Sports Safe Certificate for any team personnel in the Bench Area during the event**

What this means for you (as Team Manager/Administrator):

- A team administrator for each team will need to submit all required documentation online. NEW FOR THIS EVENT - at least one Parent/Guardian email address must be input for each player so parent may sign the required Event Liability Waiver (ELW). This is a requirement for this event and your team may not participate without its completion.
- You will need electronic copies of all team rosters, any guest player documents, Risk Management Cards, Heads Up Concussion forms for all coaches and bench personnel, and any travel approval documentation.
- Electronic documents must be in PDF or JPEG format only, and individual files cannot be larger than 4MB in size.
- Documents must be of sufficient image quality to verify information contained within.
- The deadline for submitting all required documents is **June 4th at 2pm.** |

- After documents have been reviewed and approved by Tournament Administrators, you will receive an approval notice via email. If there are any questions related to the documents submitted, Tournament Administrators will contact you for clarification and/or additional documentation.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. If a player already plays for another team in my club do I still have to get a guest player roster from MSYSA or my affiliated league for them?

YES

2. How do I do that?

Guest player rosters, passcards and medical release forms for Michigan teams can be obtained by going to the Michigan Youth Soccer Association's website at www.michiganyouthsoccer.org or call MSYSA at 734-459-6220. Out-of-state teams should contact their state association for information on obtaining these forms.

3. Can a player, play for more than one team?

NO, IMPORTANT: Players are only allowed to play for ONE team in the tournament. No player will be allowed to play for more than one team regardless of age group, gender or team. Teams that do not follow this rule will be disqualified. No double rostering allowed!

4. Can my team register at the field on Saturday prior to game ?

No, Your ONLY option for Team Check-in is via SportsForms.

5. Does everyone playing have to have a passcard or is a birth certificate okay?

Yes everyone has to have a passcard to play, that is how we know they are properly insured and No a birth certificate is not accepted in place of a passcard.

6. How do I go about obtaining a passcard if a player does not have?
